he UP Chief Minister You Adityanath has set another milestone in the history of the state. Recently, the blueprint of the proposed film city in Greater Noida was shared with eminent filmmakers and the film city region was marketed as one that would have great connectivity and other highlights such as a dedicated infotainment zone. The film city would come up on 1,000 acres of land with great rail, road and air connectivity. The project would come up in sector 21 along the Yamuna expressway and out of 1,000 acres of land 220 acres would be reserved

for commercial activities. The site of the project, which would come up as a 'Dedicated Infotainment Zone' equipped with all the world-class civil, public, and technological facilities, is just 6 km away from the upcoming Jewar Internal airport and approximately 23 km from the




